7. **John<sup>2</sup> Joseph McEnerney<sup>20</sup>** (Michael<sup>1</sup>, Francis<sup>4</sup>) was born 11 June 1898 at Newark, Essex County, New Jersey.<sup>21</sup> He died 22 November 1972 at Hornell, Steuben County, New York and was buried in St. Mary's Cemetery, Fremont, Steuben County, New York.<sup>22</sup> He married (1) **Estella May Bowen**, 20 September 1918, at Bisbee, Cochise County, Arizona (parents unknown), who was born about 1907;<sup>23</sup> (2) **Renee P. Spendlove**, about 1921, daughter of Joseph Bickerton and Pauline (Gray) Spendlove, who was born about 1910 in New Jersey. No further information. (3) **Ruth M. Clark**, 8 May 1946, daughter of Harlo Hakes and Mary Isabelle (Monahan) Clark, who was born 22 April 1925, at Hornell.<sup>24</sup>

To the time of his service in World War I, little is known of John Joseph McEnerney's early life. He enlisted in the U.S. Army 6 April 1917 and served through 8 March 1919. In a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Veteran's Compensation Application dated 2 April 1934, he listed his regular Army service as follows:<sup>25</sup>

- Fort Slocum, New York, 6 April 1917–1 May 1917
- Camp Stewart, El Paso, Texas, 1 May 1917–15 September 1917
- Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia, 15 September 1917–1 December 1917
- Douglas, Arizona, December 1917–8 March 1919

[The last post]... known as Camp Harry J. Jones, was located in and on the outskirts of the town of Douglas in Cochise County, Arizona. The post was first garrisoned in January 1911 by U.S. troops patrolling the Mexican border and subsequently served as headquarters for the Arizona District of the Mexican Border Patrol. During World

War I, the camp was utilized to organize and train new regiments for overseas duty. The post seems to have been discontinued in 1932.<sup>26</sup>

While stationed at Camp Harry J. Jones, John met and married Estella May Bowen.<sup>27</sup> It appears the marriage was not long-lived, though the couple produced one child, a daughter.

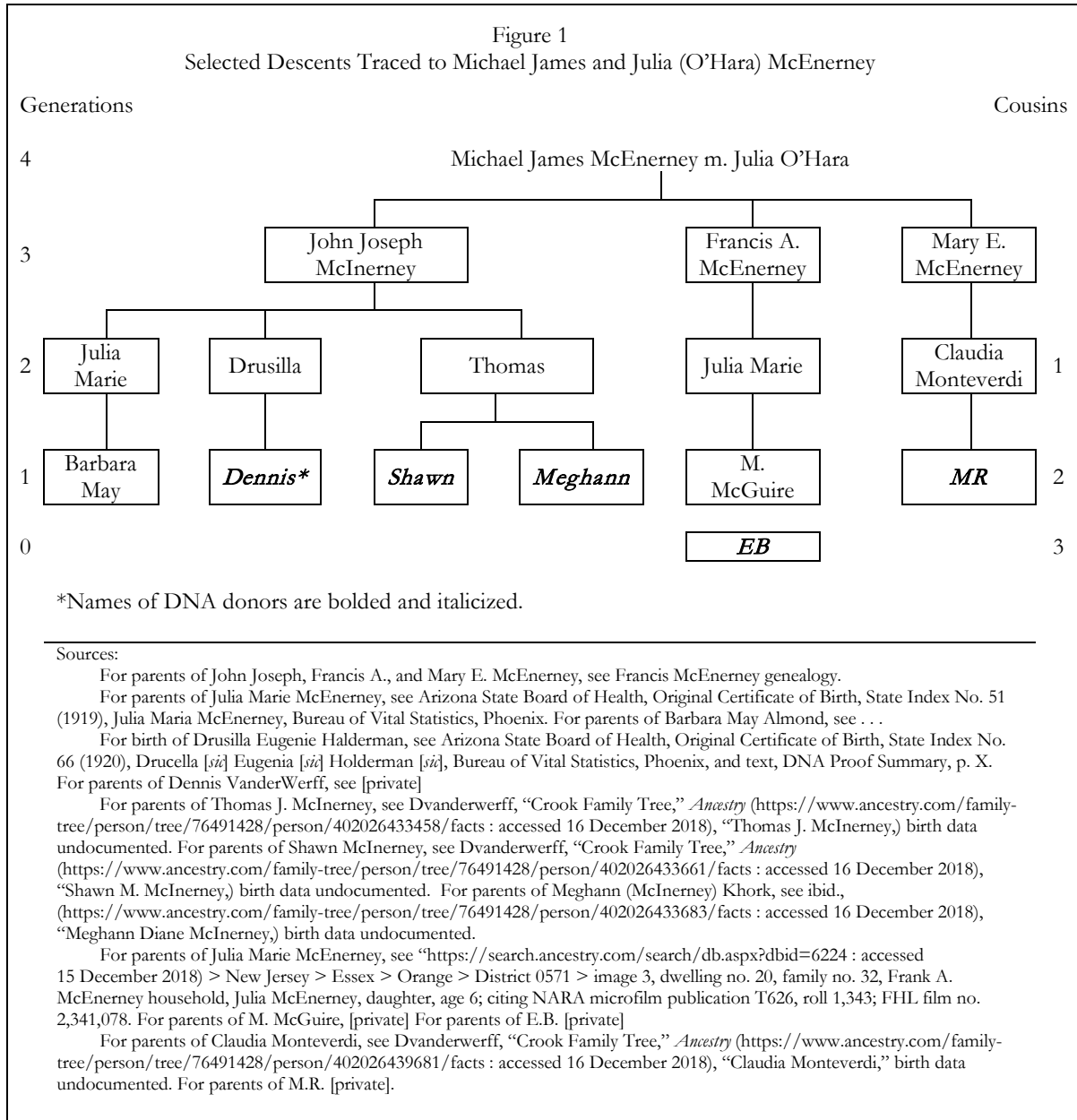

Correlation of Documentary and DNA Evidence

On 13 July 1920, Drusilla Eugenie Halderman was born in Bisbee, Cochise County, Arizona, daughter of Emma Mary Halderman and an unknown father. Documentary evidence places John Joseph McInerney in Cochise County from December 1917 to late 1919. Most DNA data, with the exception of small (< 7cMs), is direct evidence of a genetic relationship. DNA data is indirect evidence of a specific type of biological relationship and must be analyzed and correlated with documentary evidence. DNA data provide direct evidence of a genetic relationship between John Joseph McInerney and Dennis VanderWerff and indirect evidence of a biological relationship between John Joseph McInerney and Dennis VanderWerff. The data suggest John Joseph McInerney is the likely father of Drusilla Halderman:

- December 1917–8 March 1919 John Joseph McInerney was stationed at Camp Harry J. Jones, Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona.<sup>a</sup>
- 20 December 1918 John Joseph McInerney married Estella May Bowen, at Bisbee.<sup>b</sup>
- 21 August 1919 Julia “Judy” Maria McInerney, daughter of John Joseph and Estella May (Bowen) McInerney, was born at Bisbee.<sup>c</sup>
- 13 July 1920 Drusilla Eugenie Halderman, daughter of Emma Mary Halderman and unknown father, was born at Bisbee.<sup>d</sup>
- A *MyHeritageDNA* match of 383.3 cMs across 12 DNA segments between Shawn McInerney, grandson of John Joseph McInerney, and Dennis VanderWerff, son of Drusilla Halderman, indicates a genetic relationship of 1C1R-2C. See Table 1.<sup>e</sup>
- An *AncestryDNA* match of 317 cMs across 12 segments between Meghann (McInerney) Khork, granddaughter of John Joseph McInerney, and Dennis VanderWerff indicates a genetic relationship of 2C. See Table 1.<sup>f</sup>
- An *AncestryDNA* match of 216 cMs across 9 segments between MR, great grandchild of Michael James McEnerney, and Dennis VanderWerff indicates a genetic relationship of 2C. See Table 1.<sup>g</sup>
- An *AncestryDNA* match of 45 cMs across 5 segments between EB, great grandchild of Michael James McEnerney, and Dennis VanderWerff indicates a genetic relationship of 2C. See Table 1.<sup>h</sup>
